

- 3. Congress passes laws for the nation.
- 4. Voters in Virginia elected the first black governor in 1989.
- 5. New York State cannot sign a treaty with Canada or any other foreign country.
- 6. Congress cannot make a law that violates freedom of speech.
- 7. The powers of the national government are distributed among three branches of government.
- 8. The government cannot imprison a person unless there is evidence that the person has violated the law.
- 9. State and local governments have authority over public school systems.
- 10. The Senate can refuse to approve a treaty that the President has negotiated peace.
- 11. The President can veto a bill approved by the House of Representatives and the Senate.
- 12. The Supreme Court interprets and applies the law.
- 13. At the President's request, Congress declares war.
